## Praying for God's Will

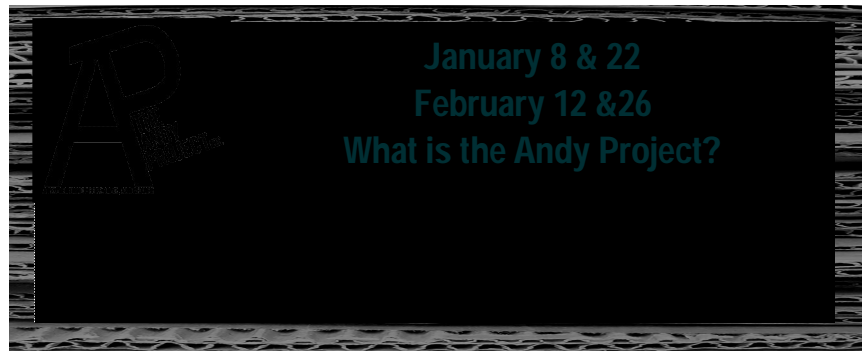
