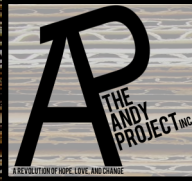

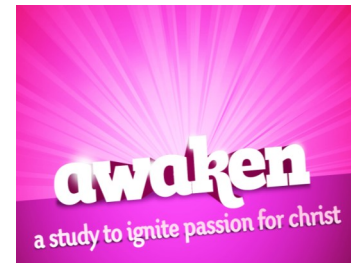
What is the Andy Project?
